Title: Setting Passenger Rates and Policies

Recitations:

WHEREAS, the Columbia County Board of commissioners resolved to develop a Columbia County Transportation Authority in Resolution # 2005-09 as authorized under RCW § 36.57.020 on Feb. 7, 2005;

WHEREAS the Columbia County Transportation Authority has, pursuant to RCW 36.57.080 acquired the funds and system of the existing transportation system previously run by the county;

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW § 36.57.080, the Authority is required to assume any debt involved with the pre-existing transportation system,

WHEREAS pursuant to RCW § 36.57.080 the Authority is the sole holder of the power to construct, acquire, maintain, operate, extend, alter, repair, control and manage public passenger transportation systems,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

The Columbia County Transportation Authority hereby adopts the rates, operating schedule and use policies as described in the brochure entitled Columbia County Public Transportation, which is attached and herein incorporated as Exhibit A.

Columbia County Public Transportation (CCPT)

strives to provide safe quality transportation to all residents of Columbia County.

Transportation is available for such programs as senior nutrition, Senior Information and Assistance, Welfare to Work, and WIC.

Transportation is also available for ICN

appointments, grocery shopping, postal business, food bank, getting children to and from babysitters, getting children to and from school, banking business, as well as for any other services provided in Columbia County.

In addition, CCPT is contracted with People For People to provide

Medicaid transportation in Columbia County as well as Walla Walla County.

CCPT provides

transportation to Walla Walla for medical and dental appointments given a one day notice.

Weekly trips to Starbucks are available when three or more persons would like to come into Dayton to take care of all of their business needs.

CCPT provides transportation to Waitsburg residents for any of their transportation needs, bringing them into Dayton or taking them on in to Walla Walla.

Weekly outings and excursions for Booker Rest Home residents and for Booker Assisted Living residents are booked through CCPT as well. All vehicles are wheelchair accessible.
