TITLE: RESOLUTION OPTING OUT OF INDEXING OF PUBLIC RECORDS

Recitations:

Whereas, the Columbia County Public Transportation Authority board finds that maintaining an index of public records would be unduly burdensome and would interfere with the agency's operations in that Columbia County Public Transportation Authority is a small agency and does not have sufficient administrative staff to maintain such an index, given the other demands and other record keeping and reporting requirements that are imposed upon Columbia County Public Transportation Authority by law, including those regulations promulgated by the Department of Transportation,

Whereas, it would therefore be in the best interests of Columbia County Public Transportation Authority to opt out of the indexing requirements of the public records act for the reasons stated above;

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

The board of the Columbia County Public Transportation Authority hereby elects to opt out of the index requirements of the public records act for the reasons stated above, and by the authority of RCW 47.17.260 (4)(a)/42.56.070(4)(a).
